The ²⁴State of South Carolina, Know all men by these Presents, that ²⁴I William Gill of Greenville district, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of thirty five dollars to me paid by Walker Brock, Have granted bargained sold, released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Walker Brock one certain Lot of Land Situate lying and being, in the village of Greenville: Courthouse in the State of S. Carolina, known and distinguished in the Plan of the said Village as laid out by "Vardry McBee" and filed in the Clerk's Office of the said district by the number thirteen (N^o 13.) in the South West square of the said Village, Beginning at a Stake corner, on Broad Street running thence S. 16. West, one hundred and forty feet along Jackson Street to a Stake, thence S. 74 E. one hundred and seventeen and an half feet to a Stake, thence N. 16. E. 140 feet to a Stake thence N. 74 W. 117 1/2 feet to the beginning, containing about half an acre. Together with all and singular the rights, members, incidents & appurtenances, to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Walker Brock his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executor and Administrators to warrant & for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Walker Brock his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and Seal, this eighth day of August in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen, and in the forty third Year of the Independence of the United States of America.
