Tarrant, Larkin Tarrant, Jattira Tarrant and Henry Tarrant their heirs, and assigns, forever all their interest and Estate, right and title of in and to all and singular the said real Estate of which the said Larkin Tarrant was seized and possessed at the time of his death. Creek to the beginning,
