The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Waddy Thompson of the district of Sumville and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Jeremiah Cleveland of the same district and state have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell to the said Jeremiah Cleveland all that tract or parcel of land in the district aforesaid and lying on the waters of Richland creek originally granted to John Simmons, and by him conveyed to Nathaniel Stokes, and by him to Elias Carl, and by Elias Carl to Henry Middleton and by Henry Middleton to me; cutting and bounding to the southward on a branch and land of Alexander Sloan (westward on land of Wardry Mcbr & northward by Henry Middleton) containing in the whole Fifty acres & seven tenths of an acre, more or less, having such shape, form, and marks as the plat hereunto annexed represents, except about one acre of the said parcel of land which I have heretofore sold and conveyed to David Manning for the establishment of a Tan yard) Together with all and singular the numerous hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises with the exception before mentioned to the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs to warrant and forever defend the premises hereby conveyed to the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs & assigns forever, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
