 & singular the said Land & premises unto the said Josiah
 Langford his heirs & assigns, against myself my heirs or any other
 person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim all or any part there
 of Witness my hand & Seal this first day February one thousand
 Eight hundred & nineteen signed sealed & delivered in the
 presence of Benjamin Malin John ^{his} Halcomb.
