by these presents that I Hugh Rogers of said state and District
for and in consideration of the sum of, Six hundred Dollars, to
to me in hand paid, by John Blasingame of the said state &
District have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release, unto the said John
Blasingame one hundred and twenty acres of Land be the same
more or less situated, laying and being in the aforesaid Dis-
-trict, on East Side Saludia River Originally granted to James
Clayton begining on White Oak, on Saludia river thence
N. 26 Degrees East 49 Chains 50 links to stake thence N 70° West
42 Chain 50 links (originally called for White oak, not found)
to willow on said river, with the Marylanders to the begining
Corner. Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and apperances to the said premises belong-
-ing or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To Have and to
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the
said John Blasingame his heirs & assigns for ever, and I do
herby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to
to Warrant and for ever defend, all and singular the premises
above mentioned, unto the said John Blasingame his heirs
and assigns against myself my heirs and against every
other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming
the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & Seal
this first day September in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and nineteen, an in the forty
fourth year of Americas Independace. Signed sealed
