State of South Carolina; Know all men by these Presents that we Thomas Tarrant and Carter Tarrant for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred & sixty four dollars, to us in hand paid by John Blasingame of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid 76000 granted bargained sold and released, and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Blasingame his heirs and assigns forever, All that Plantation or parcel of land described by a plat thereof herunto annexed, containing forty seven acres Situate lying and being in the district and State aforesaid on the Golden Grove creek being a part of a tract of land belonging to the Estate of Larkin Tarrant (deceased) Beginning on the Golden Grove creek on a Stake, S. 26 W. 24 ch. 89 links to a Black Oak, thence S. 45 E. 21 ch. 50 links to a Stake on the Golden Grove Creek, thence up the meanders of the said creek to the beginning corner; and hath such shape form and marks as the plat herunto annexed (from under the hand of Thomas Turner, Surveyor) doth represent. TOGETHER with all and singular the rights members hereunto and appurtenances to the same premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Blasingame his heirs & assigns forever, and we the said Thomas Tarrant and Carter Tarrant do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors & Administrators, and every of them to Warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said John Blasingame his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
