The State of South Carolina, I shew all men by these presents that
I Elizabeth Welch of Greenville district and State aforesaid, widow
of W^m Welch late of said district deceased, for and in considera-
-tion of the natural love and affection which I have and bear
for my two sons, to wit, James Jones aged fifteen years the 17th
day of November next (1819) and William Welch aged twelve
years the 12th day of April last (1819), and for and in consideration
of one dollar to me in hand already paid for and on account
of the said James & William, I have given granted transfer
and delivered and by these presents do fully voluntarily and
absolutely give grant and make over unto the said James Jones
and William Welch and to their heirs and assigns forever
the following described property, reserving at the same time
to myself, the full use management & control of the said
property during my natural life, or pleasure. To wit, one
negro woman now in my possession named Cloc about fifty
years old one dark complected negro girl named Peggy
about ten years old and one negro girl named Charlotte
about five or six years old; with their future increase also
two good feather beds and bedsteads & furniture, and two good
cows & calves - To have and to hold the above described
property, & future increase of the said negroes to them the
said James & William, or the survivor of them should either die
without issue, their heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby
power confirm the above mentioned property unto the said James
and William their heirs and assigns with the reservation
