

 Walker of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid, Planter, for &
 in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ninety dollars to
 me in hand paid by Jeremiah Cleveland of the district and State
 aforesaid, merchant, Have granted bargained sold and released
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
 said Jeremiah Cleveland, a certain piece or parcel of land containing
 thirty acres, be the same more or less, Situate lying and being in
 the district and State aforesaid on the North side of Rudy River -
 Beginning on a Red oak (new marked) on the North bank of the said
 River running thence North Sixty eight degrees West, two chains & forty
 links to two small dogwoods on Carter's old line, thence South Sixty
 Degrees West Forty Six chains along Carter's old line to a Stake on the
