 granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain
 and sell, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars unto
 Howard Barbary ^{Nancy Barbary} Maria Barbary ^{Patience Barbary} Washington Barbary ^{Sally Barbary} Squire Barbary ^{John Barbary}
 and Benjamin Barbary, all of the same State and district aforesaid
 my dower, or thirds of a certain tract or parcel of land late the property
 of one Benjamin Barbary deceased, containing in the whole one
 hundred and fifty acres, more or less — Situate lying and being in
 the district aforesaid on the South side of Enore River beginning
 on a Hickory on Kemps branch running up said branch bounded
 with land laid out for George Ruffel, cornering on a black oak
 running up a little branch to a Stake, thence S. W. to a Hickory
 thence South to a Poplar corner on the Mine branch, thence down
 said branch to where it enters into the cane break branch thence
 down the said branch to a dogwood corner thence W. to a black oak
 thence North to a Pine corner thence to a little branch, up said
 branch to a Maple corner thence to a white oak Stake & from thence
 to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights,
 members and incidents of my dower or thirds of the above describe
 tract or plantation of land: To have and to hold all and singular
 the same to them their heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind
 myself my Executors and Administrators, to warrant, and defend
 the same unto them their heirs and assigns from my legal re-
 presentatives, and from all other persons legally claiming or
 to claim the same. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
