 hundred & forty dollars to me paid by John Tarwater of the County of Pendle  
 ton & State aforesaid have granted bargain sold & released & by these presents  
 do grant bargain sell, release & convey unto John Tarwater a certain tract  
 of land containing one hundred & twelve acres more or less situated on both  
 sides of the middle fork of Saluda including the mouth of Gap Creek  
 beginning at a Spanish oak being John Brandons Corner & runs thence N  
 63 E. to fall Creek thence down said Creek to a spruce pine thence to a  
 stake across Gap Creek thence up D Creek to George Glancers line thence  
 along D line to a stake thence S 6 E. 23 Chains to a stake on John Brandons  
 line thence along D line to the beginning Together with all and singular the  
 rights members hereditaments & appurtenances unto the said premises  
 belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular  
 the granted premises as before mentioned with the said John Tarwater his heirs &  
 assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & assigns to warrant  
 & defend all & singular the said premises unto the John Tarwater his heirs  
 & assigns against myself my heirs & against every other person whomsoever lawfully  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof as witness my hand &  
 seal this eighteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven  
 hundred & ninety six & in the twentieth year of Americas Independence

 bargain sold and released and by these presents do  
 grant bargain sell and release unto the said David Hunning  
 a certain lot of land in the village at Granville Ct. House  
 known and distinguished in Mr. Bays Plan of the said village  
 by the number seventeen (N<sup>o</sup> 17.) in the N. East square of the D.  
 village. Beginning at a stake corner on said North boundary  
 street running thence N. 16 degrees east one hundred & twenty  
 feet to a stake near a well, thence S. 74 degrees east two  
 hundred and twenty five feet to a stake thence S. 15 degrees
