Earle his heirs and assigns forever: And do hereby as Attornies aforesaid Bind the said Henry Middleton to warrant and defend the said bargained property unto the said G. W. Earle his executors administrators or assigns against the lawful claim of any person or persons whomsoever. Witness our hands and seals this fifth day of June 1820. Beginning at a stake on the river thence N 5 E 27:5 to a dogwood thence S 65 E 35 to a post oak thence N 15 E a branch thence down the branch to the river thence up the river to the beginning. which tract of land above described. Together with all the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances: To have and to hold all and singular the premises belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Williams his heirs & assigns forever: And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors admors and assigns to warrant and defend all and singular the premises unto the said John Williams his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs and against all & every person or persons whomsoever who may or shall lawfully claim the said premises, or any part thereof.
