

139 State of South Carolina Greenville district: Know all men by these presents that I John Sammon of the state and district aforesaid for & in consideration of the natural good will, regard, and affection which I have and bear unto the baptist society or church near the head of reedy river & incorporated for the head of enow and also for divers other good causes and considerations me the said John Sammon here this day give granted, and released and by these presents do give grant, release and confirm unto the said society & church a certain parcel or part of a tract of land lying on the waters of reedy river and near where the old meeting house now stands for the full and only proper use & benefit of the said church and society; containing two acres, be the same more or less. Beginning on a red oak corner in John Hawkins line, thence S 15 W 3 ch^s 63 lks to a pine corner on said Salmon's line, thence S 75 E 5 ch^s 4 60 lks to a stake thence N 15 E 3 ch^s 63 lks to a hickory in said Hawkins line thence with said Hawkins line to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said society or church Forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Ex^{ors} and administrators to warrant and defend the said premises unto the said church or society from myself, my heirs, and from every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Know all men by these presents that I Jefe Delaney of the state aforesaid and district of Spartanburg for in consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars to me in hand paid by James Johnson of Greenville district and State aforesaid Have bargained, sold and conveyed unto said James Johnson a certain tract of land situated in Greenville district waters of Saluda river. Beginning on a black Jack on Cap^t Colb's corner from thence on a strait line to the head of a branch and down said branch till it intersects another branch from thence on a conditional line to a red oak made by John Will & Josiah Burdette from thence on a strait line to Mrs Warrins stone corner thence on Simons line, thence on Griffins line, to a chestnut corner, thence on Chrisolus line to the beginning corner, which said tract of land
