 of the sum of three hundred dollar to me in hand paid by Hugh  
 Robertson of Greenville district and state aforesaid Have granted  
 bargained, sold, & released and by these presents do grant, bargain  
 sell & release, unto the said Hugh Robinson a lot of land N<sup>o</sup> 18  
 lying within the late plan of the village of Greenville, near  
 the rock spring. Beginning on the corner of main cross & canal  
 street, at a stake running S 16 W 200 feet to a stake; thence N 74  
 W 200 feet to a stake; thence N 16 E 200 feet to a stake; thence S 74  
 E 200 to the beginning. Together with all & singular the rights, members,  
 hindritaments, & appurtenances therunto belonging in any wise appertain-  
 -ing: To have & to hold the above mentioned premises. And I the  
 said Hardy L. Fennel for myself, my heirs, executor, or adm<sup>r</sup> do hereby  
 warrant and defend the above mentioned premises to the said  
 Hugh Robinson his heirs or assigns Forever against myself, my heirs  
 & against every person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof  
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 2<sup>d</sup> day  
 of October Eighteen hundred & eighteen: In presence of us, test-

South Carolina Greenville district, Walker Brock came personally  
 before me the subscribing Justice & made oath that he saw Hardy  
 L. Fennell sign, seal, & deliver the within deed for the uses and  
 purposes therein mentioned, & that John Brown was a subscri-

 of the sum of fifty dollar to me in hand paid by John Watson Sud  
 of the district & state aforesaid. Have granted, bargained, sold & released  
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the s<sup>d</sup>  
 John Watson Sud a certain tract or parcel of land, containing one  
 hundred & fifty seven acres it being a part of a tract of land  
 originally granted to Samuel J. Histon lying & being in the district  
 and state aforesaid on the waters of Richland creek a water of ruddy  
 river, having such marks, bounds &c. as follows. Beginning on a  
 red oak corner on the Spartanburg road near Lister's shop thence  
 S 29 E 16 ch 25 lks to a white oak at a spring of water thence  
 down the branch 10 ch. to a stake on E. Gruns line thence N 65 E 2 ch  
 25 links to a hickory E. Gruns corner thence S 30 E crossing a branch  
 16 ch 50 lks to a stake on the original line thence N 65 E crossing
