Show all men by these presents that I, Adam Carruth of Greenville district for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars to me paid by William Brown of the district aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold & released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said William a tract or parcel of land laying & being in the district of Greenville aforesaid on the S^d side of Needy river, on a branch of the water thereof, Beginning at a post oak my corner thence N. 10 E. 8 Ch. 25 links to a Pine, thence N. 22 E. 15 ch. 50 lks to a Hickory thence S. 40. E. 5.6 ch. to a pine, thence N. 66. W. 48 ch to the beginning containing by estimation Sixty acres, to the same more or less the same being the N^d West or part of a survey (of three hundred acres originally granted unto John Lafferty and by him conveyed to James Hides, by him to William Bond, by him to Albert Robbins & by him to me; Patent bearing date Oct 6. 1788. Together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the above mentioned premises unto the said William Brown his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Adam Carruth do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend the above mentioned premises unto the said William Brown his heirs & assigns against me and my heirs, and against every person or persons whomsoever laying any claim or claims therunto or any part thereof.
