an consideration of one hundred and twenty dollars in hand
paid to me by E. Hannon Wells of the district of Greenville & state
of South Carolina have granted, bargained, sold, relinquished
and released & I do by these presents grant, bargain, sell,
relinquish and release unto the said E. Hannon Wells all that
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district of
Greenville & state of South Carolina containing forty acres
more or less the same being a part of a tract of land origi-
nally granted to John Lofferty on the 6th day of Oct 1788.
and laid off to me the said John Bottoms as follows.

(W.W.) Beginning on a black oak 3x from thence to a hickory
on the original line 3x from thence to an ash corner on the
branch 3x thence down the meanders of the branch to the
fork on Deals line from thence to a post oak corner 3x
thence along the original line to the beginning. Together
with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments &
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining. To have & to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said E. Hannon Wells
his heirs assigns exec & adm^{ts} forever. and I do hereby bind
myself my heirs &c. to warrant and forever defend all and
singular the said premises unto the said E. Hannon Wells
his heirs &c against myself, my heirs &c or any claim or claims
of any person or persons whatsoever. To which I have hereunto set
my hand & affixed my seal this 8th day of April 1820 & 44th year
