the bank of a small branch thence up the meanders of
said branch to the head running on a poplar thence N. 74
E to a stake near the cross paths thence along old path to
the back line thence down the line to Bates Stake corner
from thence to said large branch with John Bates line
thence down said branch to the beginning together with
all & singular the rights members hereditaments and ap-
pertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining unto the said John Shelton &
his heirs forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
& Co. to warrant & forever defend the above described premises
unto the said Shelton against myself my heirs and
against every other person or persons lawfully claiming
or to blame the same or any part thereof in writings whereof
I have set my hand & seal this 7th day of October 1820
