Know all men by these presents that I Charles Toney of Greenville District in the state aforesaid for and in consideration of Five hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas Hamilton the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have Bargained sold & delivered & do hereby bargain sell & on plain and open market deliver unto the said Thomas Hamilton Four negroes, that is to say, Rose Jesse John and Fanny to have & to hold the said Slaves with the future offspring of them and increase of the said Rose and Fanny unto the said Thomas Hamilton his heirs Executors administrators and against forever & that I Charles Toney for myself my heirs Executors and administrators do covenant promise and agree to and with the said Thomas Hamilton that I will warrant and defend the said slaves named Rose Jesse John & Fanny and their future increase unto the said Thomas Hamilton his heirs Executors adm^{rs} and assigns from and against every other person whomsoever, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Eleventh day of December 1820 Test W^m Dunklin Ben^o Arnold $\frac{3}{4}$ Charles Toney $\frac{3}{4}$

²¹³ This day Bargained Sold and acknowledged the delivery to Leonard Tarrant a Negro boy named Jack about nineteen years of age for the consideration of a security ship to W^m Toney for me for Five hundred eighty four dollars 80 cents, if I should pay said Toney this Bill of sale to be Void, should said Tarrant suffer to be Valia in proportion to the amount he my pay. this 7th of September 1820 —

²¹³ Know all men by these presents that I Robert B. Reed do make over a certain one horse waggon and gears to Benjamin Dunham as security for the payment of a Note of hand given him this day for Forty six Dollars $\frac{6}{4}$ cents mady after date. Greenville 16th March 1821.
