 for the district of Greenville vested the first manday after  
 the fourth manday of October in the year of our Lord  
 One thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty one at the suit of  
 William Farley and others against Thomas Payn to me  
 directed commanding me that on the goods and chattels lands and  
 tenements of Thomas Payn to levy the sum of Twelve hundred  
 and fifty dollars damages and cost I have seized and taken  
 of the lands and tenements of the said Thomas Payn all
