 presents that I Betsy Pollard son of the district of  
 Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of  
 Two hundred & fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Fleming  
 Thomason of the district & State aforesaid have granted  
 bargained and released & by these presents do grant Bargain sell  
 & Release unto the said Fleming Thomason one hundred & acres  
 of Land more or less being part of a tract of Land originally  
 granted to John Pyle & signed by his Excellency William Moultrie  
 On the 4<sup>th</sup> Sept 1786 the said one Hundred & acres of Land more or less  
 lying on the North side of Pyles Branch is laid out to the said Fleming  
 Thomason as follows beginning at a white oak corner the north bank  
 at the old Indian ford of the said branch and running westward  
 to a post oak station on William Louis line near the road north side  
 thence running a long William Louis line to the corner thence S. 60 E  
 to stake corner thence running S. 50 E to the said Pyles Branch thence  
 running up & bending on the north edge of the water at low water  
 mark of said Pyles branch to the beginning Excepting all the rock in  
 said branch & the quarry of Rock known by the name of the  
 White Stem quarry including one hundred acres of Land more or  
 less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments  
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
 Enclaved or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular  
 the premises be fore mentioned unto the said Fleming Thomason  
 His heirs & assigns for ever & I do here by bind myself my heirs  
 Executors & Administrators to warrant & for ever defend call and  
 singular the said one Hundred & acres of Land more or less with the  
 the premises unto the said Fleming Thomason his heirs and assigns against  
 my self self heirs and assigns & all and every other person or persons whatsoever  
 in witness where of I do here unto set my hand and seal this 17 July  
 1815 presents of
