appertinences to have and to hold all the premises
before mentioned unto the sd. Jas H. wood his heirs
and assigns forever, I do hereby bind myself my heirs
Executors, administrators or assigns towards and
forever defend the aforesaid premises against all persons
or persons in any wise claiming the said premises
or any part thereof in witness whereof I have here
unto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty
Sixth day of December Eighteen hundred and seven
ten and in presence of us the witnesses
