River to Rays line thence with Rays line to the beginning corner containing thirty Acres more or less Together with all Rights and appertinances To have & To hold all the premises Before mentioned unto The Said James Wood his heirs and assigns forever & I do here by being myself my heirs Executors administrators or assigns to warrant and forever defend the aforesaid premises against all person or persons in any wise Claiming the said premises or any part thereof in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and affixed my seal this Eighth day of October Eight hundred and sixteen and in presence of us the Witnesses William Wood & Lamech Edwards -
