42. 18. 50. to a Stake 3<sup>+</sup> thence S. W. 7 to a Stake 3<sup>+</sup>. The S. Sullivan's corner, thence down the Poplar Branch to a Stake 3<sup>+</sup> thence on the original line thence S. E. 50 to a Stake 3<sup>+</sup>. Tho. Avery's corner, thence S. W. 28. to the beginning containing fifty acres, or more

Hultit his heirs & assigns against my self my heirs & all other persons claiming the same or any Part thereof witness my hand & seal this 19<sup>th</sup> day of January 1824. & forty eight of our independance
