By these do grant Bargain sell & Release unto the said
Smith a tract or parcel of Land containing fifty
Acres, be the same more or less Beginning on a Red oak
on the north side of the waggon Road that leads to Lake
or River Cove thence along the said Road to a Spanish
Oak thence with Hugh McVey's line to a Spanish
Oak to a Chestnut thence with W. to a Chestnut thence
a conditional line to a maple corner on the River
Dam Creek thence down said Creek to a white oak
thence to a Pine knot on Kelley's line thence to a
Spanish Oak thence to the Beginning corner with
All & singular before mentioned To have & to hold
All the Rights & premises of said tract or parcel of
Land from me my heirs or assigns and I do here by
Bind my self my heirs Executors administrators
or assigns and all & Every person claiming or pre-
tending to claim the same or any part thereof
As witness where of I have set my hand and seal
