 come, I, Nimrod Underwood Sheriff of Greenville  
 District & District and State aforesaid, send greeting  
 Whereas, by virtue of a writ of fieri facias, issued out  
 of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the District  
 of Greenville tested the twenty ninth day of April  
 in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred  
 and Eighteen at the suit of George Miller to me di-  
 rected, commanding me that of the goods and Chattels  
 Lands and tenements of Joseph Clark to levy the sum  
 of twenty six dollars & sixty two and half cents damages  
 and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and ten-  
 ements of the said Joseph Clark, all that certain piece  
 Parcel and tract of land containing eight hundred  
 and seventy six acres of land more or less situate and  
 being in the district of Greenville Beginning on a Post
