Memorandum of a agreement made & entered into this 4th of
Dec. 1823 between Edward Croft and Hubbard, M. Croft agree-
-ed & consents to place & put his Boy Frederick to learn & acq-
-uire the art & mystery of a Sadler & harness maker, with Mr.
Hubbard for the space of five years, from this date & to be kept
Constantly employed at that business, only Mr. Hubbard to find
and provide said boy in four suits of cloathes each year, two
in the winter & two in the summer & one pair of shoes & hat,
one Blanket & to teach & instruct him all in his power.
It is understood between the parties, that in case either party
should remove from Greenville, in that case Mr. Croft is at
liberty to take his servant & to make a reasonable compen-
-sation to Mr. Hubbard, for such instruction as the boy
may have received or know. Mr. Hubbard to find the boy
in good & wholesome food & to treat him well &c
