of Franklin County & State of Georgia in consideration  
of four hundred dollars to me paid by Thomas W. Alexander  
of Greenville District & State of South Carolina have granted  
bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant  
bargain sell & release unto the s<sup>d</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup>. W. Alexander all  
my interest in that Grist mill & Shoal attached to the tract  
of land which I formerly deeded to him at the fork Shoal on  
Rudys River containing one acre of land & part of the Shoal  
together with all the advantages attached to s<sup>d</sup> premises and  
I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors or administrators to  
warrant & forever defend the s<sup>d</sup> premises unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas  
W. Alexander his heirs & assigns, against myself my heirs and  
against every person lawfully claiming or to claim the sa-  
me or any part thereof witness my hand & seal this thirtieth  
day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
& twenty four and in the forty ninth year of the Independence  
of the United States of America. witness
