 credits, as also of the lands leasehold Estates and
 Chattels Real, which her and may devolve, revert or
 fall to me as one of the Legates & legal Representatives
 of the said Eaton Hawkins deceased; aequable to the
 will of the said deceased and when received acquitances
 and other legal discharges in my name to seal make
 and deliver; and further to do and Execute all things
 whatsoever in the law necessary in my name
