


E. Strait with said line 5 ch. 75 E. to a post oak corner thence

 Premises unto the said Charles Garrison, and his heirs, and assigns
 against myself and my heirs and against all persons,
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the said
 premises or to any part thereof as witness whereof I
 have here unto set my hand and seal this sixth day of
 October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hund-
 red and twenty four and in the forty ninth year of the Sov-
 erignty and Independence of the united States of America
