McCullough of Greenville District in the State of aforesaid, in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have to my nephew William McCullough of the State of Pennsylvania Lancaster county and I the said William McCullough Senr. do promise to pay To William McCullough Junr. the sum of three hundred dollars in Real property at the valuation of him or the sum of three hundred to be paid in cash to William McCullough, which I do bind my self my heirs Executor, and admr. to warrant & for ever defend the same, witness my hand & Seal this 9th day of June 1825 Wm. McCullough Senr. Seal

N.B. the above property mentioned I do promise to pay to William McCullough Junr. or his heirs at their arrival in the State of South Carolina witness my hand & seal
