

Know all men by these presents, that I. Alsey Kemp,  
 of the state of South Carolina & district of Greenville,  
 for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred  
 dollars, to me paid by John Pike of the state and district  
 aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released unto  
 the said John Pike, and do by these presents do grant sell and  
 release unto the said John Pike all that tract or parcel  
 of land wheron the said Alsey Kemp, now lives lying  
 and being in Greenville district, on the west side  
 of the Enoree River, begining at a dogwood on the north  
 Branch of the Enoree from thence down the Enoree  
 River to a maple in a mill pond on the south side of  
 said River thence a strait line to a white oak & thence  
 to a white oak on the bank of the River thence down the  
 River to John Savage lower line thence west with said  
 line 27 Chains to a post oak corner, thence north 25  
 degrees west with said line across the Beaverdam to a  
 post oak corner or stake a strait conditional line between  
 Jacob Wilson and Alsey Kemp from that post oak corner  
 or stake thence a strait line to the begining corner it  
 being part of a tract originally granted to John Savage  
 and is supposed to contain one hundred and sixty  
 acres be the same more or less together with all and  
 singular the rights members hereditaments and appur  
 tenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
 incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all & singular  
 the premises before mentioned unto the said John Pike  
 his heirs and assigns forever, and I do here by bind myself  
 my heirs executors adm'rs to warrant and forever defend  
 all and singular the said premises unto the said  
 John Pike his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs  
 and against every person whomsoever lawfully claim  
 ing or to claim the same or any part thereof witness  
 My hand and seal this 12<sup>th</sup> day of December 1821 signed
