 done I seal my self my heirs my Executors administrators
 firmly by these presents sealed with my seal dated 30th Au-
 gust 1825 the condition of the above obligation is such that
 the said Edward Croft have Rec^d of the said Vardry McBee
 a Deed of conveyance for four acres & twenty three poles of
 land lying & being in view of the village of Greenville & join-
 ing the said Croft which deed contains an exception of one
 half acre of land intended by the said Vardry McBee as
 a site for an Episcopal church by an arrangement it
 is necessary the said land should be given & conveyed throu-
 gh the said Edward Croft now if the said Edward does
 well & truly give grant & convey a site of one half acre
 in good forever a part of the land offered to some person
 or persons properly appointed for the Express purpose
 of our Episcopal church with this exception that
 shall be no burial ground on the same as soon as some
 suitable arrangement is made this bond is void and
 of no effect & to be delivered up to Ed. Croft otherwise
 it will be binding in law & Equity given under my
 hand date above.
