Joseph P. Labruce of all Saints Parish in the state
aforesaid have granted, Bargained, sold and released,
and by these presents do grant, Bargain, sell and release
unto the said Joseph P. Labruce, all that tract, piece
or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the
District of Greenville, and state aforesaid on the North
side of Rudy River Beginning at a stake a corner of the
acre I sold to Amasa Spencer including the Jan-
Yard, and runs N. 28 W. 40 poles to a Black oak thence
North 68 W. 32 poles 16 links to a stake & pointers on
R. McBeus line thence along it S. 32 W. 40 poles or
16 links to a Black oak in a hollow thence a new
line S. 35 E. 29 poles and 10 links to the river thence
down the meanders of the River the courses being N.
80 E. 10 poles S. 70 E. 10 poles & 80 E. 10 poles N. 5 poles
N. 45 E. 4 poles N. 80 E. 4 poles to a Stake Spencers, corner
thence N. 15 E. 10 poles to a small hickory thence S.
75 E. 18 poles to the beginning stake corner contain-
ing by estimation Sixteen Acres three Rods twenty
two and a half perch together with all and singular
Lands, Rights, members, hereditaments and appurten-
ances to the said premises, belonging, or in any wise
incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all
