of seventy five dollars to us in hand paid by Robert
S. C. Hoster of Greenville District and State
of one said have granted bargained sold and
Released and by these presents do Grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Rob^d Hoster all our
Parts of a tract or parcel of land situated in the
District of Greenville & State aforesaid willed by John
Hoster to Francis Hoster our mother described as
follows being fifty acres of the three hundred
& forty originally granted to William
Smith conveyed from William Smith to
John Hoster and willed by the said John Hoster
to Francis Hoster from the lower end of said
tract reference may be had to the grant
which will more fully describe the same
one half of two thirds of said tract Decided
to us as heirs of Francis Hoster wife of William
Grant the whole containing about Seventeen acres
more or less together with all and singular the
said premises unto the said Rob^d Hoster his
Heirs and assigns for ever & we do hereby bind our
selves and Executors and
