 on David Vinson thence S. 70 E. 24. 50 to a Stake x 3. Bounding
 on Elizabeth Vinson thence S. 9. E. 30. 50 to a Stake x 3. Bounding
 on John Clark thence S. 79. 74 E. 40 to a Stake x 3. Bounding on
 lands belonging to the heirs of Peter Acker thence N. 7. E.
 26. 50 to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular
 the rights, minerals, hereditaments and appurtenances
 to the said premises or in any wise incident or appur-
 taining to have and to hold all and singular the said
 premises unto the said Alexander Acker his heirs and
 assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors
 and administrators and assigns to warrant and for ever
 defend all and singular the said premises unto said Alex-
 -ander Acker his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs
 and every other person who or whose lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I here-
