 me in hand paid by Jefe Moon of the State and district
 aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and released and
 by these presents do grant bargain & sell and release unto the
 sd Moon a plantation lying on Baker's Creek the waters of Pudgy
River and a part of three original grants original tracts of land
 the first to badwater Jones the second to Robert Gilliam the
 third to Charles Pope the aforesaid was granted to these men
 and conveyed around to sd Moon the same being run out by Samuel
Moore including the original deed only beginning on a Hickory
 on the edge of the old field on Pope's land 3x thence S 28 W two
 by four chains 50 L to stake thence N 62 W. thence E 80 links to stake
 thence S 28 W. twenty four E 75 links to post oak 3x thence S 50 E
 thirty four E 75 links to post oak 3x thence S 50 E thirty three E
 30 links to stake thence N 55 E fifty seven E 30 links to post oak
 dead 3x thence N 15 E two chain to stake on Spanish oak thence
 N 55 W. twenty chain to creek thence containing the same course
 to the beginning making in all two hundred and thirty acres more
 or less together with all and singular the rights members here deman-
 ds and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
 wise incident of in or to or appertaining to have and to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jefe
 Moon his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself
 my heirs Executor administration to warrant and for ever defend the
 said premises unto the said Jefe Moon his heirs and assigns against
 myself my heirs and against every other person who should ever lawfully claim
 ing or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal
 this the twenty fourth day of January Eighteen hundred and twenty
