 of Saluda River containing by Estimation three hundred  
 and twenty six acres more or less made up of two tracts  
 the first originally granted to John Maxwell beginning at  
 a Stake corner running thence N. 42. E. 44. 73 links to a hick ay  
 corner thence N. 48. W. 44. 73 links to a post oak corner thence  
 S. 42. W. 44. 73 links to a Stake corner, thence S. 48. E. 44. 73 to  
 the beginning corner which will more fully appear by having  
 reference to the original Grant and plat the second adjoin  
 -ing the tract or more described, beginning at a Stake corner  
 thence S. 54. E. 47. Chain 50 links to a Stake corner on John Bowles
