 1828. between Sterling L. Westmorland of the one part & John
 Moon of the other part, witnesseth, Whereas the said Sterling
 L. Westmorland stands indebted to the said John Moon by his
 notes, bearing even date with these presents in the sum of seven
 -ten hundred dollars. Now this Indenture witnesseth, that
 the said Sterling L. Westmorland, for & in consideration of
 the said debt, payable as appears by said notes & for the
 better securing the payment thereof, I the said Sterling L. Westm
 orland do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said John
 Moon & to his heirs & assigns for ever all that plantation or
 tract of Land on which he now lives, containing 256 acres
 more or less bounded on the East by Enos River, on the
 North by Christopher McCrays land; on the West by Josiah
 Filgoes land & on the South by land belonging to the
 Estate of John Westmorland deceased together with all and
 singular the rights, members & appurtenances thereto belong
 ing or in any wise incident or appertaining to have
 and to hold the said tract of land with the appurten
 ances, unto the said John Moon his heirs and assigns for ever
 provided always never the less & it is the true intent & mean
 ing of the parties to these presents, that if the said Sterling L. Westmor
 land his heirs Ex^{ec}utors or adm'ts shall well & truly pay the said note
 with Costs & Interest then these presents shall be utterly null
