Sullivan Jr all that plantation or tract of land containing fifty one acres more or less situate ate in the dist aforesaid lying on the Branches of Rudy River beginning on a Red oak 3x running thence N. 50 E 28.20 to a Stake 3x thence N. 30 W 19 to a red oak 3x thence S. 50 W 27.75 to a Stake 3x thence S. 41 E 7.90 to a white Oak 3x thence S. 21 E 11 to the beginning Together with all & singular the rights, members, Hereditaments, & appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident, or appertaining to Have & to Hold, all & singular the premises, be fore mentioned unto the sd. H. Sullivan his heirs & assigns for ever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & for ever defend all & singular the sd. premises unto the sd. H. Sullivan his heirs & assigns against ourselves & our heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof —
