 McDaniel Sheriff of Greenville district, and State aforesaid send  
 Greeting Whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out  
 of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville  
 Tuted the twenty second day of April in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand Eight hundred and twenty Eight at the suit of  
 Issiah Kilgore and also James Wilcox to me directed  
 Commanding me that of the good and Chattels, Lands and tenur  
 ents of Wilson K. Cily to levy the sum of one hundred  
 and thirty five dollars damages and Costs. I have seized and  
 taken of the lands and tenements of the said Wilson K. Cily all  
 that certain piece, parcel and tract of Land, containing three  
 hundred and thirty one acres be the same more or less situate and  
 being in the district of Greenville on the branches of Giddens Creek waters  
 of Enore River it being a part of a tract originally granted  
 to Prince by his Excellency John Drayton the first of December 1800.  
 beginning on a chestnut thence S. 25. E. 34. to a Stake 34 thence
