Know all men by these presents that I Archibald Fowler of Greenville district in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two hundred and eighty three dollars to me paid by Robert W. Roper of Charleston district in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert W. Roper a certain tract piece or parcel of land situate in Greenville District in the State aforesaid on the Waters of Rocky Creek of Enoree River, including the summit of what is usually called Fulshus Mountain it being part of a tract of land originally granted to John Goodwin bearing date the third day of September A.D. 1787. Beginning at a Stake 3x on a branch the neare a crop said branch S^o 60^W 46.38 ch, to a black oak 3x thence S^o 30^E 17.50 ch to a Stake 3x by a Post Oak thence N^o 60^E 46.38 ch to a Stake by a field thence N^o 30^E 17.50 ch to the beginning containing Eighty one acres. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premise, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert W. Roper his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert W. Roper his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this twenty seventh day of October one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight and fifty third year of the Independence of the United States
