Crowder Sheriff of Greenville District, and State aforesaid, bind Yelling: Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the district aforesaid on the fourth day of November in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twenty two at the suit of the Ex'trs of George W. Earle to me directed commanding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of Charles Bryant to levy the sum of eighteen dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the aforesaid sum of the said Charles Bryant all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, containing one hundred acres situate and being in the district of Greenville it being a part of three hundred and thirty seven acres originally granted to Edward Howard by patent bearing date 22 January 1795 & Recorded in grant Book V No 5. Page 179 on a branch of Reynolds Creek beginning on a R 0.3+ thence W. 32 chains to a P. oak 3+ thence 1.35 chains to a pine 3+ thence E. 32 to a sp. 0.3+ N 31 chains to the beginning Red oak 3+ it being the part that was granted to Charles Bryant And whereas the said premises with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased by Joseph Bryant of the district and state aforesaid for the sum of twelve dollars being the highest sum that was bidden therefor. Now Know Ye, that I Asa W. Crowder Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of twelve dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Joseph Bryant the receipt and payment whereof, I do hereby acknowledge Have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Bryant his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances and all the Estate, right, title and interest which the said Charles Bryant of Right had of in and to the same To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances, unto the said Joseph Bryant his heirs and assigns for ever, as fully and absolutely and
