 tween Hisannah Pickett widow for her self on the one part and James
 Pickett for himself on the other part witnesseth that the said
 Hisannah was to board with the said James during of her life
 for which boarding she was to pay the said James annually two dol-
 lars for each week for her self and also pay fifty Cents for each
 week for her friends which was in the boarding one hundred and
 thirty dollars for each year with interest until paid also the
 negro man Jim had become old and was not worth for
 his labour more than his clothes and shoes and Taxing as such
 it was a quid on that the said negro man Jim was to work
 during of his life for his clothes and shoes and Taxing also let it
 be further remembred that if the said negro man Jim become
 unable to work by sickness or old age then in that case the said
 Hisannah was and is to pay to the said James fifty Cents for
 each week for the boarding and Cloathing of said negro man
 Jim during of his life and also and further the said Hisannah
 was and is to pay the said James for all cloathing or articles of
 any description that he may furnish the said Hisannah with
 during of his life also to pay the said James for all medical aid
 also it was a quid between the parties that the said James was
 to keep the accounts of all costs and Expinditers against the
 said Hisannah of every description whatsoever during of the said
 Hisannah life and she was to pay all accounts with interest
 thereon until paid as witness hereunto we do set our hands
 and seals this 29th day of June in the year of our Lord
 A.D. 1829.
