E. 45. ch. to a stake corner thence S. 89. E. 50. ch. to Black Oak the beginning corner - also one other Tract adjoining the above tract containing sixty five acres more or less beginning on a stake on Jany Jordans line running N. on said line to a Black Oak corner thence N. a long said Jordans line to a stake ~~branch~~ corner, thence S. 0. 55.
