 grant bargain, sell, release and convey unto the said Commissioners  
 and their Successors in office all that piece parcel and tract of land  
 situated lying and being in the district of Greenville aforesaid  
 Beginning at a stake near a rock and running thence S. 66. E. 3. 75.  
 to a stake thence No. 34. E. sixty two feet to a stake thence No. 44. W. 3. 50  
 to a stake on the Spartanburgh Road leading by the Tan Yard and then  
 -ce S. 39. W. 2. 25 along the said Spartanburgh Road to the beginning  
 corner } together with all and singular the rights, liberties, heredi-  
 -taments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in  
 any wise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE and to HOLD, all and  
 singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Commis-  
 -sioners and their Successors in office for ever, in trust for the Citizens  
 of the Town of Greenville and its vicinity for the sole and exclusive  
 use of a Cemetery or Grave yard, to be appropriated entirely  
 as a repository for white persons to the Exclusion of Slaves and  
 persons of Colour. Provided also, that the said Commissioners  
 or their Successors shall have the price of land & have discri-
