

bed and conveyed neatly fenced in and a gate established for an entrance thereto, then and in that case the fee simple of the said piece of land shall vest absolutely in the said Commissioners as trustees as aforesaid for the use, aforesaid. But should they permit slaves and persons of colour to be deposited within the bounds aforesaid or fail to enclose the same as aforesaid then this deed to be void and the right to the said Land to revert. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Commissioners and their Successors Trustees as aforesaid against myself and my Heirs and against every other person claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this ninth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine and in the fifty fourth year of the American Independence

Know ye that I the said Alexander McKinney for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto my daughter Sarah Hood wife of Nipper Hood and also for the good causes and considerations me therein to moving HAVE given and granted and by these presents do give grant and confirm unto the said Sarah Hood her heirs and assigns for ever three negroes to wit Elizabeth, Judah and Jefferson with their future increase and issue to have and to hold all and singular the said three negroes Elizabeth, Judah and Jefferson unto the said Sarah Hood and the heirs of her body for ever to ~~have~~ her own proper use and behoof to belong.
