State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents
that I Josiah Parrott of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty
dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin Nelson of the State
and district aforesaid have granted bargained and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release to the said
Benjamin Nelson one hundred and sixty acres of land being the
same more or less the said land lying on the south side of
Pyles branch water of Reedy River Originally granted
to James A. Pollard and signed by his Excellency Joseph
Atkinson on the 1st Nov. 1814 and laid out as follows begin-
ning on a pine not corner on Thompson Dickersons line
thence to a black Jack thence to a white oak on the south side
of Pyles branch thence up the meanders of said branch to a condi-
tional corner on said branch thence W to a R. O. thence S. 9° W. 15° 20'
to a chestnut 3x thence S. 30° E. 39° 20' to sd J. Dickersons 3x thence N. E. a
long sd Dickersons line to the beginning including one hundred and
sixty acres of land more or less together with all and singular the
rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
as belonging in or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and
to hold all and singular the premises, before mentioned, unto the
said Benjamin Nelson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
bind myself my heirs and Executors to warrant and for ever
defend the same unto the said Benjamin Nelson his heirs and
assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and every other per-
son or persons what- ever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have set my
hand and seal this the 8th February 1826 in presence of
Samuel Carter, Samuel Rice

South Carolina Personally came Samuel Rice before me one of the Justices of the
Greenville District Peace for said District and being duly sworn saith on oath that
he saw Josiah Parrott sign seal and deliver the within deed of Conveyance to
Benjamin Nelson for the use & purpose within mentioned and that he also saw
Samuel Carter sign the same as a concuring witness with himself sworn
to and subscribed before me the 9th October 1829
