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State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I Adam Lester of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me in hand paid at and before the signing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged have bargained granted granted and sold unto John Bamarr of Spartanburg district State aforesaid a certain tract or parcel of land whereon I now reside situated in Greenville District on the waters of South and Middle Tyger Rivers containing by estimation two hundred acres and bounded as follows viz. One tract or parcel of one hundred and fifty acres more or less conveyed from John M. Lester to me beginning on a sawer wood corner the same being a conditional corner between Robert Langford and Jesse Sparks running thence S. or Conditional line to the Burnam's Road thence with said Road to a stone corner thence to a branch thence down said branch Robert Langford's line on a stake corner thence N. to a red oak corner thence N. to a chestnut thence E. to a chestnut thence S.E. up said to a stake on the Burnam's Creek thence with the meanders of said creek to the mouth of a branch thence up said branch to the beginning corner and also one other tract of forty eight acres more or less conveyed from John Hoan to me and bounded as follows beginning on a red oak near the path leading from the main Road to Capt. Lewis running S. 76. W. 39.
