 taining to Have and to hold all and singular the premises before men  
 tioned to him and his heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby bind  
 myself my<sup>146</sup> heirs executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto him the said Joel  
 Allison his heirs and assigns in trust for the said Baptist Society
