Samuel Rhea, in the sum of two hundred dollars and being willing
and desirous to bequeath to the said Adam Elrod the true and faithful
payment of the above described note according to the true intent and
meaning thereof. Now I know all men by these presents that I Harda-
way Huff for the better securing the payment of said note have
bargained sold & delivered & by these presents do bargain sell and
deliver unto the said Adam Elrod a certain tract of land
containing two hundred acres more or less situated in Greenville District
and described in a deed of conveyance made by Nimrod
