The State of South Carolina <sup>304</sup> Know all men by these presents that I William Greenville District - Taylor of said District & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety five dollars to me in hand paid by free Strike formerly the slave of Isreal Miller of the same District and State aforesaid Have bargained Granted sold & released and by these presents do bargain grant sell & release unto the said free Strike a certain plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres in the same more or less situate in Greenville Dist & State aforesaid on a small branch of Enoree being part of a tract of five hundred acres Conveyed from Isaac Preston to the sd William Taylor beginning at a poplar corner & runs S. 2 E. 40 chains B. 0. 3 & N. 80 10. 31. 50 chains to P. 3 & thence N. 19 E. 48. 28. chains to maple 3 & on the south side of a branch thence down the remainder of said branch to the beginning which contains the land to be conveyed together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenance thereto belonging so hereby warrant and for ever defend the rights and titles of the aforesaid premises unto the sd free Strike his heirs Executors & administrators to be held in trust by the sd Strike, future guardian for sd Strike and his heirs for ever, against myself my heirs Executors & Administrators and against any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 28<sup>th</sup> October A.D 1838 and the fifty second Year of the American Independence
